(21) Former Bishop's Court

No. 17 | At the rear of this plot there is still the tower of the former Bishop's Court. Until 1420 the court was one of the power centres of Prague.

22 Beethoven house No. 9 A beautiful palace where both Mozart and Beethoven spent the night.

No. 22 | There is a swimming pool on the roof of this house. A UNESCO heritage wonder? We suppose so.

25 "Radečák"

The square known today as "Malostraňák" is, for the old-timers, simply "Radečák". It was named after one military leader – marshal Radetzky. Johann Strauss actually composed an honour song for him, which is still played today by the Vienna Orchestra in celebration of New Year's Eve.

26 Newest house in Mostecká street

No. 21 | You would not guess that this house is so new - built in 1963!
